## English

The Children have loved Rhyme of the week, and we will continue this for the rest of the year. The children start Phonics this term and each week we will be learning initial letter sounds through the 'Little Wandle' activities. Activities at the start of this term will focus on the story 'Susan Laughs' moving on to 'The Jolly Christmas Postman' and stories about the nativity.

#### Maths

Maths activities this term will focus on the number 2 and later in the term patterns. Children will have lots of opportunities to count and order objects. We will use our seasonal changes in our outdoor classroom to make patterns and count natural resources such as leaves. We will be introducing an Advent Calendar nearer to Christmas and the children can count and create patterns with parcels wrapped by themselves.

### Wider Curriculum

This term our topic focuses on understanding emotions. We will be learning words to describe how we are feeling and how our emotions have an impact on others. I will be utilising a variety of books at story time to help develop this theme as well as activities around the classroom. It's a busy term for festivals and the children have thoroughly enjoyed learning about Diwali this week, they will also be learning about Hanukkah and Christmas.

Their positive attitudes to learning meant we achieved all our pom poms and stickers resulting in a party at the end of term which they thoroughly enjoyed.
