Spellings:

Sent home on a Friday and practised a minimum of 5 times over the week.

Overviews were sent out this week. Please do let me know if your child requires another copy.

Completed spelling sheets must be placed in the homework tray every Friday morning.

Reading:

Reading regularly at home, will improve your child's reading speed and comprehension. Please encourage your child to read regularly and talk to them about their reading to help them develop these crucial skills.

Children are expected to read a minimum of 3 times a week and recorded in their reading record on a weekly basis.

In Year 6, I expect children to be reading more than the minimum expectation.

Reading records must be in school every day regardless of whether your child has read or not.

<u>P.E:</u>

P.E will be on a **Thursday afternoon.** Children will need to ensure they wear their P.E kit into school. Kits are white top and black jogging bottoms/shorts/leggings and appropriate footwear. Daily times table practise – We will continue with our KFS times tables, starting with the 10 times table.


Weekly times table test – Each Friday, the class will complete their Cracking times table test.
