Spellings:

Spellings should be practised at home 5 times a week and are sent out every Friday.

Reading:

Reading regularly at home, will improve your child's reading speed and comprehension. Please encourage your child to read regularly and talk to them about their reading to help them develop these crucial skills.

English

In writing, we are focussing on key fantasy features in narrative such as metaphor, simile and descriptive devices to create a sense of wonder for the reader. In reading, we will be developing our inference and comprehension skills to aid our understanding of a text. We will also be developing reading fluency through guided group reads.



E-ACT The Kingfisher

Core texts: This term we are looking at the text 'Nen and the lonely fisherman' a beautiful story about friendship and compassion. We will be using this text to write our own narratives based on the fantasy theme. In reading, we are looking at a rather chilling tale; 'Ice Palace' – can Ivan save his brother from the mysterious Starjik?

Mathematics

Core Maths lessons – At the beginning of the term we will be focusing on addition and subtraction using concrete resources, pictures and the column method. Later in the term we will be starting our unit on multiplication and division.

Daily times table practise – We will continue with our KFS times tables. We have completed our 10s, 5s and 2s – now we will move onto our 3s and 4s.

Weekly times table test – Each Friday, the class will complete their Cracking times table test.
